

Lafayette College Smoking Policy

To provide a healthy and welcoming environment for employees, students, and visitors, smoking is not permitted:

- In any Lafayette College building, including private offices, classrooms, residence halls, restrooms, and all other indoor spaces.
- Within 25 feet of any college building entrance, exit, operable window, air intake system, or ventilation equipment.
- In any college-owned or college-rented vehicles.

For purposes of this policy, smoking includes the use of all smoking and nicotine delivery products, including but not limited to cigarettes, cigars, pipes, electronic cigarettes (e-cigarettes), vape devices, vaporizers, hookahs, and any other electronic or non-electronic smoking or nicotine delivery systems. This would also include any recreational or medical use of marijuana.

However, smoking is permitted in outdoor smoking areas designated by the college and may be established or modified as operational needs require. Smoking receptacles ("smoking boxes"), for the disposal of smoking materials, will be installed in the following locations:

- 1001 Bushkill Drive
- Fence line behind Bourger Varsity Football House (by the gravel lot)
- Watson Courts (by Watson A)
- Leopard Parking Deck Gravel Lot
- Buck Hall Parking Lot (not under the garage area)
- Markle Parking Deck (across from AEC loading dock)
- Marquis Hall (wall behind the loading dock)
- Williams Center for the Arts (parking lot)

Members of the college community and visitors are expected to comply with this policy at all times. Failure to comply may result in corrective action consistent with applicable college policies and procedures.
